

USING YOUR OWN ELECTRICAL ITEMS,
such as lights, showcases, extension cords, equipment, etc?

**PLEASE READ THIS
IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

All electrical items not supplied by J.O.G.S. official contractors must meet or exceed the electrical code requirements of the Pima County Fire Marshall, Tucson Expo Center and your contract with J.O.G.S.:

1. Your lights and electrical equipment must have UL or equivalent ratings visible on them.
(note: Low voltage (12 volt) components are exempt, all 110/220V items must meet the above)
2. Your lights including all electrical components, equipment and all wiring including extension cords, connecting to the ordered electrical outlet(s) must be three-wire and grounded throughout your entire system including connections to the power source.
(note: Low voltage (12 volt) components are exempt, all 110/220V items must meet the above)
3. You must order the proper wattage outlet from J.O.G.S. to power your lights and equipment. Please, see electrical order form.

Exhibitor installations will be examined and your 100% compliance to the electrical code requirements is required for the safety of your staff and those around you at the show. Violations if correctable will require correction on the show floor involving at-show pricing and may involve electrician hourly labor charges to your company.

Violators will be dealt with accordingly including the possibility of having your exhibit closed down at the show by the Fire Marshall and/or proper authorities.
